We were incredibly fortunate to meet Deb and her husband, Lane, two years ago when they were seeking volunteer opportunities with homes like Refugio Mazatlán. Since Deb began volunteering with us in January 2023, she has worked closely with our staff and the boys. Her contributions have been invaluable in helping us become more organized and sustainable, and most importantly, in achieving our goals for the boys.

Deb implemented a wellness program designed to enhance mental health and resilience for both the staff and the boys. She also introduced trauma training for the staff, creating trauma-competent caregivers who can effectively support individuals who have experienced trauma. More recently, she has assisted our coordinator and psychologist in developing programs that provide individual academic and emotional plans for the boys.

Deb has provided immense support to our director and staff, and she has patiently and relentlessly worked with the boys both academically and emotionally. Many thanks, Deb – we deeply appreciate all that you have done and continue to do.
